

68th MISS GUAM LIBERATION QUEEN CONTEST

RULES & REGULATIONS

PART 1 – GUIDELINES/RULES

1. Contestant must be a born female, a U.S. citizen and a resident of Guam for at least six (6) months before July 21, 2012. _____
2. Contestant must be a minimum of sixteen (16) years of age by January 01, 2012 and not have reached her 26th birthday by January 01, 2013 and must have a valid U.S. Passport. _____
3. Contestant must be single, never have been married or never have been pregnant or get pregnant during her candidacy and/or reign. _____
4. Contestant must be in good health physically and mentally and be able to perform official duties related to the 68th Miss Guam Liberation Queen.
5. Contestant must be of good moral character and not have been involved at any time in any act of moral turpitude and/or convicted of a felony offense. _____
6. Candidate must not have any visible body arts (tattoos), body piercing (except for earrings) or tongue rings. _____
7. Contestant agrees to be personally interviewed by a sponsor. Contestant must receive the final approval of the sponsor to be officially entered as a contestant. _____
8. Contestant is required to sell or purchase a **minimum of one thousand dollars (\$1000)** in raffle tickets by the first counting and payments made thereof. For every ticket sold subsequent to the initial \$1,000 each contestant and sponsor will receive a percentage of the proceeds from ticket sales based on the table below and the remaining balance will go to the 2012 Guam Liberation Queen’s Committee. _____

9. Contestants will be issued raffle tickets in incremental batches and are required to turn in ticket stubs and remit payments before additional batches of tickets can be issued. _____
10. A first and a final counting of all tickets sold will be held at a designated bank. The Queen’s Committee will provide notice of the official counting dates and location. Due to the secured location and limited space, contestants must be present at each counting event and accompanied by only one adult. _____
11. Personal checks, cash or other certified bank negotiable drafts are acceptable on the first counting. **Only cash, certified bank checks, or money orders are acceptable on the final counting.** Any returned items plus any bank charges will be deducted from the contestant’s total submission and not be credited as sold tickets. The contestant with the highest amount of tickets sold and paid for after all tickets are accounted for on the final counting shall become Queen-designate of the 2012 Miss Guam Liberation Queen contest. The contestant with the second highest number of tickets sold and accounted for shall become Royal Princess-designate. All other contestants shall be a part of the Royal Court. _____

PART II – AWARDS/PRIZES

- 12. All Contestants will receive a formal gown, a tiara, a bouquet of flowers, and a trophy. ____
- 13. The 2012 Liberation Queen will receive: ____
 - a.) a trip to Manila, Philippines after the final counting
 - b.) a 20 x 20 parade spot by the Grandstand on Liberation Day
 - c.) a framed photo of the Queen
- 14. The Queen must have raised over \$10,000 in order to qualify for a trip to Washington D.C. towards the end of her reign in 2013. The date and time of travel will be determined by the Queen’s Committee. ____
- 15. The Queen will receive a Sash with the Title, a crown, cloak, scepter, together with a bouquet of roses and a trophy. She must be able to perform, represent, and be an Ambassador of Guam for all Official activities and events on and off-island. If the newly designated Queen after she is crowned cannot fulfill all of the express duties, or violates any rule set forth in the guidelines, **she will immediately relinquish her title, crown and scepter upon the direction of the Queen’s Committee Chairperson.** The Royal Princess will then be eligible and given the title as the 2012 Liberation Queen. ____
- 16. The contestant with the second highest number of tickets sold and accounted for shall become Royal Princess-designate. The newly designated Queen and Royal Princess must sign a copy of these rules and other terms of agreement which will serve as the official contract with the 68th Liberation Festivities Guam Island Fair throughout her year of reign. ____
- 17. The contestant with the third highest number of tickets sold and accounted for shall be named 1st Runner-up. ____
- 18. The Queen, Royal Princess, and the 1st Runner-up shall be determined by the Queen’s Committee and awarded at the Coronation on June 30, 2012. ____
- 19. Prerequisite and duties of the newly selected Queen and Royal Princess
 - (a) The Queen and Royal Princess will represent the 2012 Liberation Festivities Committee at as many functions as possible during their reign during and after the Liberation Day Festivities. The Queen and her court will be provided escorts or chaperones by the Queen’s Committee. ____
 - (b) Personal appearances, photo sessions, or requests for product endorsements as the Guam Liberation Queen or Royal Court shall be approved in advance by the Chairperson of the Queen’s Committee. ____
- 20. Other rules and regulations may be added by the Queen’s Committee from time to time if it will be for the benefit of the proper decorum of the entire 2012 Miss Guam Liberation Queen Contest. ____
