1. Contestant must be a born female, be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Guam for at least six (6) months before July 21, 2014. \_\_\_\_\_
2. Contestant must be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age by January 1, 2014 and must not have reached her 26<sup>th</sup> birthday by January 1, 2014. \_\_\_\_\_
3. Contestant must possess a valid U.S. passport. Passport must be at least six (6) months from expiration date from the final counting. \_\_\_\_\_
4. Contestant must be single, never have been pregnant or get pregnant during her candidacy and/or reign. \_\_\_\_\_
5. Contestant must be in good physical and mental health and be able to perform official duties required of the 2014 Miss Liberation Queen and the Royal Court. \_\_\_\_\_
6. Contestant must be of good moral character and not have been involved at any time in any act of moral turpitude and/or convicted of a felony offense. \_\_\_\_\_
7. Contestant must not have any visible body arts (tattoos), body piercings (earrings are the only exception) and/or a tongue ring. \_\_\_\_\_
8. Contestant agrees to be personally interviewed by a sponsor. Contestant must receive the final approval of the sponsor to be officially entered in the contest. \_\_\_\_\_
9. Contestant is required to sell or purchase a **minimum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)** of raffle tickets by the first counting (Wednesday, May 14, 2014) and payments made thereof. \_\_\_\_\_

10. For every ticket sold subsequent to the initial \$1,500.00 each contestant and sponsor will receive a percentage of the proceeds from their individual ticket sales based on the table below and the remaining balance will go to the 2014 Guam liberation Queen's Committee. \_\_\_\_\_

11. Contestants and sponsors will be issued 2000 raffle books each (4000 raffle books total) initially and may only request for additional raffle books after the first 2000 are sold. Additional booklets will be issued in increments of 1000 maximum. \_\_\_\_\_
12. The first counting is scheduled for Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at 6:30pm at the Bank of Guam Hagatna Branch. The final counting is scheduled for Monday, June 16, 2014 at 6:30pm at the Bank of Guam Hagatna Branch. Due to the secured location and limited space, only contestants and sponsors or sponsor representative and no more than two (2) alternates should be present at each counting. \_\_\_\_\_
13. Personal/business checks, cash or other certified bank negotiable drafts are acceptable up to twelve (12) business days prior to the first and final counting. All personal/business checks must be received no later than twelve (12) business days before the counting to allow for clearance. Any returned items plus any bank charges will be deducted from the contestant and sponsor's final submission and not be credited as tickets sold. \_\_\_\_\_
14. Only certified bank checks (cashier's checks) or money orders will be accepted at both the first and the final counting \_\_\_\_\_
15. All Contestants will receive a formal gown, two island wear dresses or blouses, a tiara, accessories, a bouquet of flowers, and a trophy.
16. The 2014 Liberation Queen will receive:
- a. A 20 x 20 parade spot by the Grandstand on Liberation Day \_\_\_\_\_
  - b. A framed photo of the Queen \_\_\_\_\_

17. With the title the 2014 Liberation Queen will receive a Sash, a crown, cloak, scepter, together with a bouquet of roses and a trophy. She must be able to perform, represent, and be an Ambassador of Guam for all Official activities and events on and off-island. If the newly designated Queen after she is crowned cannot fulfill all of the express duties, or violates any rule set forth in the guidelines, ***she will immediately relinquish her title, crown and scepter upon the direction of the Queen's Committee Chairperson.*** The Royal Princess will then be eligible and given the title as the 2014 Liberation Queen \_\_\_\_\_
18. The contestant with the second highest number of tickets sold and accounted for shall become Royal Princess-designate. The newly designated Queen and Royal Princess must sign a copy of these rules and other terms of agreement which will serve as the official contract with the 69<sup>th</sup> Liberation Festivities Guam Island Fair throughout her year of reign \_\_\_\_\_
19. The contestant with the third highest number of tickets sold and accounted for shall be named 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up \_\_\_\_\_
20. The Queen, Royal Princess, and the 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up shall be determined by the Queen's Committee and awarded at the coronation ceremony on June 28, 2014. \_\_\_\_\_
21. Prerequisite and duties of the newly selected Liberation Queen and Royal Princess other rules and regulations may be added by the Queen's Committee from time to time if it will be for the benefit of the proper decorum of the 2014 Miss Guam Liberation Queen Contest. \_\_\_\_\_
  - a. The Queen and Royal Princess will represent the 2014 Liberation Festivities Committee at as many functions as possible during their reign during and after the Liberation Day Festivities. The Queen and her Royal Court will be provided escorts or chaperones by the Queen's Committee. \_\_\_\_\_
  - b. Personal appearances, photo sessions, or requests for product endorsements as the Guam Liberation Queen and/or the Royal Court shall be approved in advance by the Chairperson of the Queen's Committee. \_\_\_\_\_
