VII. 004-25	<b>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT – <i>Joy Jean R. Arceo</i></b>
A.	The Executive Director announced she has signed a Purchase Order on December 30 <sup>th</sup> to purchase computers for all 19 villages to include Mayors’ Council of Guam main office, delivery date tentatively by the end of March. Executive Director indicated it would be 3 computers per village to help modernize the Mayor’s Office. The funding was provided by the Administration and Mayors’ Council secured the contract for the computers.
B.	The Executive Director announced she conducted a training session with the New Mayors, Vice Mayors and designated staff for a total of three days last week to cover daily operations. Additionally MCOG and Executive Director will conduct an Operations Training on February 12 and 13 at the Guam Homeland Security from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. topics will include Procurement, Payroll, Invoices, Fleet program, Recycling Fund Program, etc.
C.	The Executive Director announced the FY 2026 Budget submission to the Guam Legislature is due by mid-March.
D.	Mayor Lizama inquired about the supplemental budget of 2025 balance that was supposed to be given to the each Mayor Office. President Alig responded an Accountant was employed to help Executive Director with the finances. Both Executive Director and Accountant are reconciling lapses, and prior year expenses.
