EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT - Joy Jean Arceo
The Executive Director announced that the week of the procurement
training the central office received 15 work requests and procurement
planning having the central office successfully process 25-purchase orders.
The Executive Director announced that the Mayors' Council received its

central office is working on consolidating the FY 2023 and 2024, which the
deadline will be at the end of November to provide necessary information.
The Executive Director announced the Orientation for the new Mayors / Vice
Mayors-Elect will be on November 8, 2024 at 10AM in the MCOG

VIII. 005-25	COMMITTEE REPORTS
A.	Boards and Commissions – President made an announcement regarding the lawn maintenance of GDOE schools and requested that the GDOE Representative, Mayor Savares to inform the GDOE Board that Mayors are not responsible for the upkeep of their facilities. Mayor Savares voiced her concerns about the scope of work and if there is a contract in place, to utilize the vendors.
1. (a)	President, Mayor Alig addressed Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) and Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) and how they can be beneficial to

	villages ex: The Child Development Grants and the Villages Qualifying Certificate (QC)
2. (b)	Grants have made a positive impact to the 19 villages. President recognized Mayor Hoffman as the Representative at Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) to speak on the matter.
3. (c)	The President and Vice President both agreed that the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) should be responsible for the upkeep of the tourist attractions and maintenance of grass cutting on the roads to help promote value for our island.
4. (d)	The Vice President encourages the Mayors to do what is best for their own villages in correspondence to the tourism industry and the economy and take in their respective villages.
5. (e)	Vice Mayor, Christopher Fejeran highlights that Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) should invest in the villages and not just Tumon as the only tourist attraction.
6. (f)	Mayor, Johnny Quinata states that the light fixtures need to be fixed in the parks to alleviate illegal dumping in the areas that tourists often frequent.
7. (g)	Vice President acknowledges resource management, homelessness and product development. Vice President talks about the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget Request and the formula of the community impact fee.
8. (h)	Secretary, Mayor Louise Rivera spoke on the issues of crime, stray animals and how to remedy that problem.
9. (i)	Vice President acknowledges the concerns brought up by Mayor Johnny Quinata and agrees that the government should do more to help. Vice President encourages Mayors to assess and note what parks, historical sites and the challenges they face in their respective areas that would help formulate future development.
10. (j)	President addresses Public Law 37-60 and the importance. President notated that he has taken action by submitting photos of the abandoned vehicles on public easement to the Director/Deputy Director of Public Works and cited Public Law 37-60 and Department of Public Works (DPW) then disposed of vehicles.
